

2011 Prevalence of Founded Allegation Child Abuse Cases Per U.S. Census Block Group: This map of the Colorado Springs metro area shows the prevalence of Founded Allegation child abuse cases per 1000 people per U.S. Census Block Group. The light-yellow areas represent those census block groups with the lowest prevalence of founded child abuse cases, while the increasingly darker areas represent block groups with a higher prevalence of cases, capped by the darkest areas of 10-14.5 cases per 1000 people. The thick dark gray and light gray lines show the areas of high (greater than 100 referrals per square mile) and moderate (greater than 75, but less than 100 referrals per square mile) DHS referral density, as seen on the "2011 Referral Density Per Square Mile" map. The population data was provided by the United States Census Bureau and the 2010 American Community Survey (ACS), while the child abuse data was provided by the El Paso County Department of Human Services.
