

E.2011-2014 Moderate and High Density Referral Areas: This map of the Colorado Springs metro area shows the moderate and high density areas from each year, 2011 through 2014. The solid lines show the areas of high (greater than 100 referrals per square mile) for each year, while the dotted lines show the areas of moderate (greater than 75, but less than 100 referrals per square mile) DHS referral density for each year, as seen on the "Referral Density Per Square Mile" maps. The colored stars show the locations of child fatalities from each year. All data for each year is color-coded: 2011 (Red), 2012 (Blue), 2013 (Green), 2014 (Black). A quick analysis shows that the high and moderate density areas are slowly expanding, particularly to the west and southwest, with one 2014 moderate axis extending to the north.
